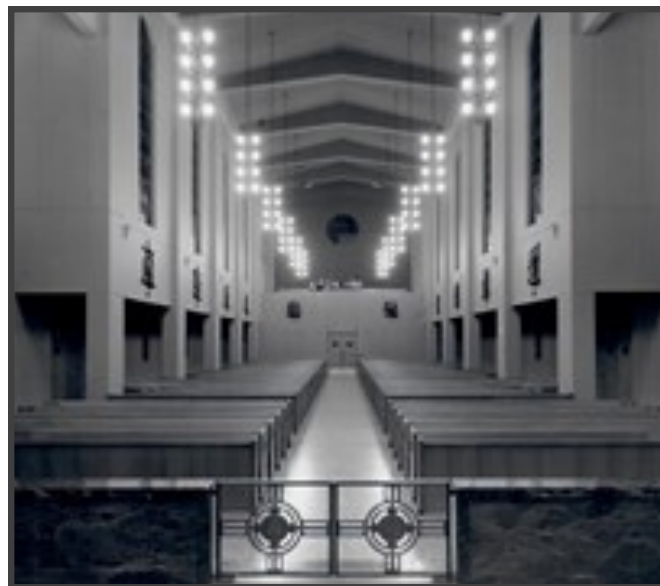

This is the view of the nave and balcony from the original St. Augustine Parish sanctuary. Since 1950, the parish has made many updates. The altar gates moved to the alcove with the “Risen Christ” icon in the back of the church. The parish also added the Jose and Conception Dueñas memorial pipe organ, the baptismal font and crown, and the ambry for holy oils used in the celebration of the sacraments.
